Body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing Creek in the County aforesaid the third Tuesday day of March anno Domini our thousand seven hundred and thirty six to answer unto Giddion Tilman of a plea of trespass upon the case &c and that thereof he should not fail &c

At which day here before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset aforesaid  
Duing Creek came the aforesd John White by Francis Allen his attorney and the Sheriff of the  
County aforesd to wit Joseph McClester gent at the same day here returned that he had  
taken the aforesd John White whose body hereat this daye he had ready to answer the aforesd  
Giddion Tilman of the aforesd plea astchim it was comittanted &c

And the said John White by Francis Allen his attorney cometh hereinto Court and therec  
upon at the request of the parties day is given to the parties aforesd to before the Justices  
of his Lordships County Court of Somerset at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of June then  
next following in the state wherein they now are saving to the parties aforesd &c

at which day here came the aforesd John White by his attorney aforesd and the said Giddion  
Tilman his witt aforesd against the aforesd John White did not prosecute - Therefore he  
and his pledges of prosecuting being querey and Lett the plte name of pledges &c and that  
the aforesd John White ge therof without day also it is considered that the aforesd John  
White recover against the aforesd Giddion Tilman his damages by occasion of the  
premises to: pounds of tobacco
