Body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing
Creeke in the County aforesaid the third Tuesday of March Anno Domini thousand seven
hundred and thirty six to answer unto Giddion Tilman of a plea of trespass upon the
Case &c - and that thereof he should not fail &c

At which day here before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset at di-
viding Creeke came the aforesaid John White by Francis Allen his attorney and the sheriffe of the
County aforesaid to witt Joseph M^{ce} Lester Gent^e at the same day here returned that he had
taken the aforesaid John White whose body here at this day he had ready to answer the aforesaid
Giddion Tilman of the aforesaid plea as to him it was commanded &c

And the said John White by Francis Allen his attorney cometh here into Court and there-
upon at the request of the parties day is given to the parties aforesaid to before the Justices
of his Lordships County Court of Somerset at dividing Creeke the third Tuesday of June then
next following in the state wherein they now are saving to the parties aforesaid &c

At which day here came the aforesaid John White by his attorney aforesaid and the said Giddion
Tilman his writt aforesaid against the aforesaid John White did not prosecute - Therefore he
and his pledges of prosecuting being mercy and lett the p^l name pledged &c and that
the aforesaid John White goe thereof without day altho it is considered that the aforesaid John
White recover against the aforesaid Giddion Tilman his damages by occasion of the
premises to: pounds of tobacco
