in their bailiwick and him should safe keep so that they might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing creek in the same County the third Tuesday of June Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred thirty seven to satisfy Joshua Caldwell of twenty three pounds twelve shillings and four pence Curr money of Maryland and eleven hundred and eighty two pounds of tobacco which to the same Joshua in the same Court before the Justices thereof at dividing creek aforesaid were adjudged for his damages which he had by reason of a certain promise and assumption to the same Joshua by the aforesaid Joseph made and not performed wherefore he is Committed - All which day here before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset at dividing creek Cometh aforesaid Comers to wit Henry Ballard and Wm Lane Gent and at the same day here returned that they had taken the aforesaid Joseph M<sup>ce</sup> Lester whose body here at this day they had ready to satisfy & as to them it was Comanded - YOU Joseph M<sup>ce</sup> Lester Benjamin Townsend and Daniel Corder doe Confess Judgment to Joshua Caldwell for the sum of twenty three pounds twelve shillings and four pence Curr money of Maryland and eleven hundred and eighty two pounds of tobacco which sum was recovered by the said Joshua Caldwell against Joseph M<sup>ce</sup> Lester on the fifteenth day of March last in the Somerset County Court the said money and tobacco to be Levied of your bodies goods or Chattles Lands or Tenements for the use of the said Joshua Caldwell in case the said Joseph M<sup>ce</sup> Lester shall not pay and satisfy to the said Joshua Caldwell the said sum of twenty three pounds twelve shillings and four pence and eleven hundred and eighty two pounds of tobacco so as aforesaid Recovered against him with the additional Cost therein on the tenth day of February next June 1737 taken and acknowledged before me
