Gen<sup>l</sup> hath transmitted unto this Court the account of the Estate of W<sup>m</sup> Wilson dec<sup>d</sup>  
wherein it is found, that there is ball<sup>ly</sup> due to the abovesaid orphans the sum of  
twentyfour pounds eleven shillings and twopence Curr. money thereof if the abovesaid  
Thomas White his heirs Executors or administrators shall and do well and truly  
pay or cause to be paid unto the abovesaid orphans the sum of twentyfour pounds  
eleven shillings and two <sup>pence</sup> according to act of assembly and the deceaseds will  
when they shall arrive at full age to receive the same &c. Then the above obligation  
to be void and of none effect otherwise to remain in full force and virtue &c.
