A copy of the foregoing declaration and warrant were made and sent to be served on the afo^rd William with the
writ afo^r according to act of assembly in such case made and provided -

All which said third Tuesday of June anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and Thirty seven Cometh
here the said Robert Graham by his attorney &c and the Sheriff of the same County to wit Joseph M^r Lester Gant
at the same day here returned that he had taken the said William Wye whose body heretofore he had ready
to answer unto the afo^r Robert Graham of the afo^r plea as to him it was commanded and likewise that he
had served the afo^r William with the copy of the declaration afo^r as by law lawfully enjoyed by —
Whereupon came hereinto Court before the said Justice George Dashiel of Somerset County Gentleman
undertook for the said William Wye and affirmed upon himself that if it should happen that Judgm^t
in the plea afo^r in the same Court should be tendered for the said Robt^r Graham against the said Tom.
Wye or that the same William Wye should be knowne convicted that then to the said William Wye —
should pay and satisfy unto the said Robert Graham the Judge of the Court thereupon or tender
his body unto execution of such Judgment to the prison of the Sheriff of the County afo^r thereto remane until
the same Judgment be fully satisfied or that the said Geo^r Dashiel will do the same for him —

And the afo^r William Wye by Francis Allen his attorney Cometh and defendeth the same and Injuring
when he and the afo^r Robert prays that the afo^r him to his declaration afo^r may answer whereupon
the afo^r William hath day wherein by the first here given to answer b^r and the same William at the
same day solemnly called to answer Cometh not nor the same attorney of the same William says —
nothing to proof in bar or preclusion of the action afo^r of the afo^r Robert by which the same Robert
languisht thereof against the same William wholly undefended b^r for which reason the same
Robert his damages by Reason of the non performance of the promise and assumption afo^r ag^t
the same William ought to recover but because it is not known unto the Justices of the Lord Lieu^r
County Court of Somerset how what damages the same Robert in that part hath sustained therefore
it is commanded the Sheriff of Somerset County that by his Oath of honest and Lawfull men of
his Bailewick or County he diligently inquire what damages the same Robert hath sustained
as well by Reason of the non performance of the promise and assumption afo^r as for his cost
and charges by him about his suit in that part appeared and the Inquisition which thereupon he
Shall take he make appear to the Justices of his Lord Lieu^r County Court of Somerset to be
held at Dodington in som^r County the third Tuesday of August then next following and
on his Seal and the Seals of those by whose Oath he take that same Inquisition be —
