Orphan being above the age of fourteen years came herunto Court in his proper
person and pray, that he may be admitted to those aforesaid Thomas Maddox the Elder
as his Guardian which is by the Court hereunto him granted &c. Thereupon the said Thomas
Maddox the Younger present here in Court made Chose of the said Thomas Maddox the Elder as his
Guardian &c. Whereupon it is ordered by the Court here that aforesaid William Ford do deliver
up unto the said Thomas Maddox the Elder all the Estate of the said Thomas Maddox the Younger that
he hath in his hands both real and personall and Likewise it is further ordered by the Court
here that the said Thomas Maddox the Elder give good security for to comply with the Guardian
ship of &c. Thereupon the said Thomas Maddox the Elder with Stephen Dorney and John Millburn
of Somerset County planters all present here in Court in their proper persons acknowledged them-
selves indebted unto the said Thomas Maddox the Younger for one hundred pounds Sterling Good
and Lawfull money of England of their bodies goods or Chattells Land or tenements Royalty
and severally to the Use of the said Thomas Maddox the Younger his heirs or assigns to be made
and Levied If it happen that the said Thomas Maddox the Elder do not comply with the Law
in relation to such Guardianships as aforesaid and do not deliver up unto the said Thomas Maddox
the Younger his heirs or assigns all his Estate both real and personall that he shall take into
his hands and possession peaceably and quietly whensoever he shall be legally required &c

Henry Jermain License
& Recognizance to keep
Edmury

Henry Jermain of Somerset County plantholder came
here into Court in his proper person and prays that he have the
Liberty to keep an ordinary or house of Entertainment in Snowhill
Town in the County aforesaid for the Use and Conveniency of the Inhabitants travellers and
Strangers, as to them respectively shall seeme, which is by the Court hereunto him
granted, he giving security according to act of Assembly in such case made and provided &c.

Whereupon the said Henry Jermain with Littleton Townsends and Jonathan Stunges
both of the County aforesaid planters his securitys all present here in Court in their proper persons
acknowledged themselves indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary of the
Province of Maryland in the sum of five pounds Curr. money of their goods and Chattells
Lands
