Whereupon the said James Rownd with James Martin & Edward Rownd both of the County afo Gent. his securitys all present herein Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves Indebted unto His Lordship the Lord proprietary of the province of maryland in the sum of five pound Court money of their goods and Chattles Lands and tenements Joyfully and severally to be made and Levied to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors if it happen that the said James Rownd do and shall not pay unto his said Lordship fifty shillings Court money of maryland for every year he shall keep such ordinary or house of entertainment &c Likewise the said James Rownd with James Martin and Edward Rownd his securitys afo all present herein Court in their proper persons afo acknowledged themselves Indebted unto his Lordship the Lord proprietary in the sum of forty pound Court money of maryland of their goods and Chattles Lands and tenements Joyfully and severally to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and successors to be made and levied if it happen that the said James Rownd do not keep good rules and orders and do suffer Idle loose and disorderly persons to tippole game or commit disorders or other Irregularities in his ordinary or house of entertainment during the time that he shall keep the same contrary to the true intent and meaning of the act of assembly in such case made and provided &c
