to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors if it happen that the said  
John Wildman do and shall not pay unto his said Lordship fifty shillings Curr:  
money of Maryland for every year he shall keep such ordinary or house  
of entertainment &c Likewise the said John Wildman with James Rownd  
and Edward Rownd his securitys all present herein Court in their proper  
persons acknowledged themselves indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary  
in the sum of forty pounds Curr: money of Maryland of their goods and  
Chattles Lands and tenements Joyntly and severally to the use of his said  
Lordship his heirs and Successors to be made and levied If it happen that the  
said John Wildman do not keep good rules and orders and do suffer idle loose and disor-  
derly persons to tipple game or commit disorders or other Irregularities in his  
ordinary or house of entertainment during the time that he shall keep the same  
Contrary to the true intent meaning of the act of assembly in such case made and provi-  
ded &c
