Likewise the said Abraham Cordery with Alexander Lackie and Robert Collier his securitys all present herein Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves Indebted unto His Lordship the Lord Proprietary in the sum of forty pounds Court money of Maryland of their goods and Chattles Lands and Tenements Joyntly and severally to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors to be made and levied if it happen that the said Abraham Cordery do not keep good rules and orders and do suffer Idle loose and disorderly persons to tipple game or Commit Disorders or other Irregularities in his ordinary or house of entertainment during the time that he shall keep the same Contrary to the true Intent and meaning of the act of assembly in such case made and provided &c
