be held at dividing Creek in the same County the first Tuesday of September then next to answer such
suspicion of perjury on the presentment aforesaid which is ordered to be transmitted to some Justice or his determination
Whereupon the said Isaiah Bredell with Charles Rank life of Somerset
County gave his security both present herein Court neither proper persons and acknowledged themselves
indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary of the province of Maryland in fifty pounds Sterling
each good and lawfull money of England of their goods and Chattels Land and tenements severally to
be made and levied to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors If it happen that the said
Isaiah Bredell do and shall not make his personall appearance before the Justices of a free and quietoyer
and good delivery to be held at dividing Creek the first Tuesday of September
then next and do not answer unto his said Lordship on suspicion of perjury aforesaid and do not stand
and abide the Judgment of the Court thereon and do depart the same Court without leave and in
the mean time if he be not of the good behaviour towards his said Lordship and all his good people
then he

Likewise Charles Rank life of Somerset County Gent Rane Clarke James Mumford
and Samuel Shewell of the same County planters all present herein Court in their proper persons
acknowledged themselves indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary of the province of
Maryland in the sum of twenty pounds Sterling each good and lawfull money of England of
their severall goods and Chattels Lands and tenements to the use of his said Lordship his Lord
Proprietary his heirs and Successors If it happen that the said Charles Rank life Rane Clarke
James Mumford and Samuel Shewell do not make their personall appearance before
his said Lordships Justices of a free and quietoyer and good delivery
to be held at dividing Creek in the same County the first Tuesday of September then next
and do not then and there give such evidence as they and each of them shall have on
behalf of his Lordship against the aforesaid Isaiah Bredell on suspicion of perjury and
do depart the same Court without leave then
