foue and injury wher^e he and saith that he is not guilty of the premises above upon him imputed
as the afo^d Jacob above against him hath complained and of this he puts himself upon the
Country and of said Jacob in like manner .

Thereupon it is command^d the Sheriff of the County afo^d that immediately he shal cause to come
him before the Justices of his Lordship^s County Court of Somerset Adiuiding Creek this instant .
Third Tuesday of August twelveth by whomth and who neitherth to recognizeth because as wellth &
the same day is given to the afo^d parties here fore and the Jurors of that County by John Henry
Gen^tl^r Sheriff of the same County up to this Impannelled being called came to wit Edmund Hough
Joshua Caldwell John Lopp Alexander Lukie Samuel Long Robert Collier Nehemiah Holland
John Gorsten William Turgis John Covington Benjamin Holland and Robert Mihel whoth say
the truth of the premises afo^d being duly sealed tryed and sworn upon their Oath do say that James
Grey is guilty of the premises afo^d in manner and forme as the afo^d Jacob Wagaman above against
him hath complained and abovesth the afo^d Jacob by occasion of the premises
afo^d beyond his costs and charges in that part exposed to six pounds eleven shillings and
eight pence curr^t money of Maryland and for those costs and charges to one pound of tobacco

Therefore it is considered that the afo^d Jacob Wagaman recover against
the afo^d James Grey his damages aforesaid by the Jurors afo^d in sum afo^d apes as also
Twelve hundred & fifty seven ----- pounds of tobacco for his costs and charges afo^d to the
same Jacob by the count^s of his afo^d Court of Justice adjudged which certain damages in the
whole do amount to six pounds ----- eleven shillings and eight pence curr^t money of Maryland
and twelve hundred and fifty eight ----- pounds of tobacco of afo^d James in Maryland
