at the publick whipping post with twenty five stripes on the bare back well laid on until the blood appear it being adjudged full satisfaction for his offence aforesaid and afterwards in the same Court came the said Sheriff and made return that he had done his Execution of the Judgment as to the corporal punishment aforesaid he was commanded &c — Whereupon it is ordered by the Court here that the said Mary Crowley give security to save and keep indemnified the Justices of Somerset County and their Successors from all Costs Charges and Burthenes that might accrue by means of the birth of the Child aforesaid —

Whereupon the said Mary Crowley with Thomas Denwood of Somerset County <sup>their surgeon having</sup> present here in Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves indebted unto his Lordship the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary in forty pounds Sterling each of their bodies goods or Chattels Lands or tenements severally to be made and served to the use of the Justices of the County aforesaid and their Successors if it happen that the said Mary Crowley her Heirs Executors or Administrators or any of them do and shall not from time to time, and at all times hereafter ought discharge and save harmless as well the Justices of the County aforesaid and their Successors for the time being as also the Inhabitants of the said County of and from all Costs Charges troublous and Inconveniences whatsoever for or by reason of the birth maintenance nourishing and — bringing up of the said Child and of and from all other Suites Charges troublous and demands — whatsoever touching or concerning of the same her — Whereupon the aforesaid Thomas Denwood pray that the said Mary Crowley may be adjudged to serve him for the trouble of his labour when delivered of the aforesaid Child and the Expences that he was at by the Crown aforesaid —

Whereupon the said Mary Crowley is adjudged by the Court here that she serve the said Mr Thomas Denwood six full months being adjudged full satisfaction for the trouble of the house and Expences aforesaid by means of the said Child aforesaid which said six months service to commence at the Execution of her already servitude ordered that she return to her Master serving her to pay her according to Law her —
