It is Considered that the aforesaid Jane Tucker be whipt at the publick whipping post with ten stripes on the bare back well laid on untill the blood appear and that she be taken &c.

And thereupon as to the Corporall punishment aforesaid Command is given to the sheriff of Somerset County that he do thereof Immediate Execution by whipping of the aforesaid Jane Tucker at the publick whipping post with ten Strips on the bare back well laid on untill the Blood appear &c. and afterwards in the same Court came the said sheriff and made return to the same Court that he had done the Execution of the Indictment aforesaid as to the Corporall punishment aforesaid he was Comanded &c. *not to pay fees of being the Murther*

did make and the same Cornelius then and there did beat wound and wilfully treat so that of his
life it was much despaired and other harms to him then and there did to the great damage of the
same Cornelius and against the peace of the said Lord that now is his good Rule and Government
&c. Whereupon the same attorney of the said Lord proprietary for the same Lord proprietary
prayeth the advice of the Court here in the premises and that due process of law in this part
against
