Also appraisement of the Rental Value of the real estate of John Gale and William R. Gale minors of Kent County Maryland made by John W. Corey and William W. Stephens June 17th, 1873.

Estate called Camels-worthmore, occupied by Mr John Miller, contains about three hundred and forty acres, one hundred acres being in wood and timber. The balance is divided in five fields and under good fencing.
