



We the Subscribers Appointed by the Orphan's Court of Kent Co, and being duly authorized to view the estate of Isaac E. Heally Lewis son Heally and Eugene Heally (decd) minor in the hands of Isaac Heally (Col) Guardian and to estimate the annual value whereof after having taken the required oath, do hereby certify and return that we have viewed the estate of said minors and estimated the annual value thereof, at Thirty Four Dollars, or one half of all the grain and other produce raised on the lands, of which the said heirs are entitled to the aforesaid sum or rent,

The principal portion of the land lays back from the public road from Pines Store to Barnards wharf and contains about Thirty acres. Fourteen acres divided into three lots two of the lots under fair fence, the other only faintly enclosed and a part of that is in bad condition. The balance of the aforesaid tract is a sparsely wooded Hill side and branch, and without any other improvements. There is also a lot of about an acre or three quarters under fair fence adjoining the (lot) Peoples Church known as the union near Pines Store, without improvements.
