Thereupon it is Comanded the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should Take the said George Taylor if he be to answer &c. and afterwards to wit the sixteenth day of June before his Lordships Justice at about then held at dividing Creek (and the said George Taylor in his proper person according to a certain Recognizance by him in this part first acknowledged and had a hearing of the Information aforesaid and sayeth that he cannot deny but that he is guilty of the premises in the Information aforesaid specified above upon him imposed in manner and form as by the Information aforesaid above against him supposed and the premises in the Information aforesaid Expressly acknowledgeth

Whereupon all and singular the premises being seen and by the Court hereofly understood. It is Considered by the Court here that the aforesaid George Taylor pay unto his said Lordship the Right Honorable the Lord Proprietary of Maryland for his fine by the Court hereupon him imposed for and by Occasion of the premises aforesaid in form of &c. is Comitt thirty shillings Curr. money of Maryland and that the said George Taylor be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of the fine aforesaid

Whereupon the said George Taylor is ordered to give Security to save and keep Indemnified the Justices of <sup>the County of</sup> Somerset and their Successors from all troubles burthens and Charges that might accrue by means of the birth and maintainance and bringing up of the Child aforesaid

Thereupon the said George Taylor with James M. Daniel & James Noble both of Somerset County planters his Securitys all present here in Court in their proper person Acknowledged themselves Indebted unto his Lordship the right Honorable the Lord Proprietary of the province of Maryland in thirty pounds Curr. money of their Goods goods or Chattles lands or tenements severally to be made & levied to the use of the Inhabitants of the County of Somerset for the time being if it happen that the said George Taylor James M. Daniel and James Noble their heirs Exors. Admors. or any or either of them doe not from time to time, or at all times hereafter acquit, discharge and save harmless, as well the Justices of Somerset County Court for the time being as also the Inhabitants of said County, of and from all Costs Charges and burthens whatsoever for or by reason of the birth maintainance norishing and bringing up of the said Child, and of and from all other suits Charges troubles and demands whatsoever touching or concerning of the same &c.

Whereupon the said George Taylor is Ordered to give Security for the payment of all fees or fees due to any person or persons on the Information aforesaid. Thereupon a certain James M. Daniel of Somerset County planter present here in Court undertook for the said George Taylor for the payment of all fees or fees due to any person or persons on the Information aforesaid in case the said George Taylor doth not pay the same &c.
