

Seven hundred and forty one before John Scott Esq^r and his associates the said Lord Proprietary his Justices of the same County Court and for the same Lord Proprietary doth give the Justices here to understand and be informed that William Jarman late of all-hallow Parish in the said County of Somerset planter the sixth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and forty with force and arms at the parish of St. Andrew in the County of St. Andrew within the Jurisdiction of this Court in and upon a certain Daniel Dennis in the peace of God and the same Lord Proprietary then and there being and assault did make and him the said Daniel then and there did beat wound and evilly treat to the grievous damage of him the said Daniel and contrary to the peace of the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary that now is his good Rule and Government and against the form of the act of assembly in such case made and provided Whereupon the same attorney of the said Lord Proprietary prays Advice of the Court here in the premises and that due process of Law in this part against the said William Jarman, may be made to answer the same Lord Proprietary of and upon the premises &c.

Thereupon it is commanded the sheriff of the County of Somerset that he should take the said William Jarman if he should be found in his bailiwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of June One thousand seven hundred and forty one to answer unto his said Lordship of the Information &c.

And Now to wit at that same Court held for the County of St. Andrew the third Tuesday of June being the sixteenth day of the same month Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and forty one before the Justices of St. Andrew at dividing Creek came the said William Jarman in his proper person and had a hearing of the Information &c. and saith that he cannot deny but that he is guilty of the premises &c. in the Information &c. specified above against him Imposed as by the Information &c. against him supposed and the premises in the Information &c. expressly acknowledgeth . . . Whereupon all and singular the premises being seen and by the Court here fully understood. It is considered by the Court here that the said William Jarman, pay unto his Lordship the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary of the province of Maryland for his fine by the Court here upon him Imposed for and by occasion of the premises &c. whereof in form &c. he is convicted two shillings and six pence current money of Maryland and that the said W^m. Jarman be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of the fine &c.

Whereupon the said William Jarman is ordered to give security for the payment of all fee or fees due on the Information &c. to any person or persons whatsoever. Thereupon a
