Lately made and provided the said William became chargeable to pay to the said Henry ~~as aforesaid~~ ^{in consideration hereafter to be paid to him in the same amount to be given at the rate} the said sum according to the tenor of that note, and, whereas the said William afterwards,

to wit on the ^{xix} day of January Anno Domini MDCCXL at the County Afo. did make

his certain other note in writing called a promissory note and the said last named note.

with the proper mark of the said William signed to the said Henry then and there did

deliver by which note last named the said William did promise to pay to the said Henry three pounds nine shillings curr. money of Maryland for value received to be paid nevertheless if the said William should faithfully serve the said Henry in every lawfull employment for the space of two months after the date of this note by means whereof the said William

became chargeable to pay to the said Henry the said sum in the said last named note contained on his failing or refusing to serve the time in the said note mentioned according to the tenor of the said note and so being thereof chargeable on consideration thereof afterwards to wit this

day and year Afo. at the County Afo. promised to pay the money in the said last note mentioned

on his failing or refusing to serve the time in the said note mentioned and whereas the said

William afterwards to wit on the ^{xix} day of January Anno Domini MDCCXL at the County

Afo. did make his one other note in writing called a promissory note and the said last named

note with the proper mark of the said William subscribed to the said Henry then and

there did deliver by which last note the said William promised to pay to the said Henry

or his order thirty two shillings and six pence curr. money of Maryland at or before the

fiftieth day of march then next ensuing the date of that note or on failure thereof

to serve the said Henry in all lawfull employments by the space of two months by means

whereof and by force of the statute in that case lately made and provided the said William

became chargeable to pay to the said Henry the sum in the said note named or versus the

said Henry the time in the note mentioned on his failing of payment of the mony -

last mentioned and so being thereof chargeable in consideration thereof afterwards to wit the

said ^{xix} day of January in this year Afo. at the County Afo. promised to pay the money i.e.

the said last note named or failing to do the same according to the tenor thereof to serve the said Henry.
