At which day here came again as well the as: Francis Allen Junr. as the as: Robert Geddes and Susannah his wife by their Attorneys as: and whereupon the said Robert and Susannah as before defend the force and Injury when & say that the said Susannah is not guilty of the premises by the said Francis above upon her Imposed in manner and form as the said Francis above against them hath complained and of this they put themselves upon the Country — And the plst. in like manner

Therefore it is Comanded the Sherife that Immediately he cause to come here before his Lordships Justices Twelve & by whom & and who neither & to Requirize & becaun as well & and whereupon the aforesaid Francis Allen Junr. then and there his writt aforesaid against the aforesaid Robert Geddes and Susannah his wife did not proceed with Effect but voluntarily suffered his suit to be discontinued.

Therefore it is Considered that the aforesaid Francis Allen Junr. and his pledges of Prosecuting to wit John Doe and Richard Roe are in mercy and that the aforesaid Robert Geddes and Susannah his wife goe thereof without day &. Also it is Considered that the aforesaid Robert Geddes and Susannah his wife recover against the aforesaid Francis Allen Junr. three hundred and Sixty One pounds of Tobacco for their Costs and Charges by them about their defence in that part sustained to the same Robert and Susannah by their Court here of their about adjudged according to the form of the Statute here of lately made and provided and that the aforesaid Robert and Susannah have thereof Execution &

Command was given to the sheriffe of Somerset County that he should take Hugh Henry of Somerset County planter and dictus Hugh Henry if he should be found in his Bailiwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of November anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty nine to answer unto Alex: Bunckle of a plea that he tender unto him twelve pounds nine shillings and ten pence half penny Court money of Maryland which to him he owes and unjustly detains &. And the same day is given to the aforesaid Alexander here &

At which day here came the as: Alex: Bunckle by George Douglas his attorney and the sheriffe to wit John Henry Gent now here returned that he had taken the as: Hugh Henry whose body here at this day he had ready to answer the as: Alexander Bunckle of the as: plea as to him it was Comanded &
