

Chattles of the said John Evans towards Satisfying unto the said Nehemiah King his damages and all Costs and Charges accruing by means of the attachment aforesaid.

Thereupon George Douglas of Somerset County Gentleman present herein Court in his proper person undertook for the said Nehemiah King according to act of assembly in such case made and provided that In case the said John Evans, do at any time within a year and aday appear and make all or any part of the said Nehemiah Kings, Claims against him, appear to be satisfied, or have been indue, before the Laying of this attachment, that then the said Nehemiah King shall make Restitution, unto the said John Evans, of all, or such part ^{hereof} as the said John shall make appear to be indue &c. or that he the said George Douglas will do it for him &c.

Therefore it is Considered by the Court here, that the aforesaid Five hundred and Sixty pounds of Tobacco, and One hundred and Sixteen pounds of Imbroak Glass, of the value of Ten pounds of Tobacco, so as aforesaid acknowledged by the aforesaid Sarah Roe J^r, be Comdemned in the hands of the said Sarah Roe J^r, as of the goods and Chattles of the aforesaid John Evans, towards Satisfying unto the said Nehemiah King his damages aforesaid, and all Costs and Charges accruing by means of the attachment aforesaid, and that the said Nehemiah have thereof Execution &c. Whereupon the aforesaid Sarah Roe J^r an Other of the Garnishes, of the aforesaid John Evans, discharged by the said Nehemiah King of and from the attachment aforesaid &c.

Command was given to the sheriffs of Somerset County that he should take Barnard Ramsey late of Somerset County planter if he should be found in his bailiwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing trees the third Tuesday of June Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and forty one to answer unto William Bowly of a plea of trespass upon the Case &c. and the same day is given to the said William here &c. And hereupon the said William declared against the said Barnard in the plea &c. in form following. . . . Somerset s^r Barnard Ramsey late of Somerset County planter was attached to answer unto William Bowly of a plea of trespass upon the Case &c. . . . And Whereupon the said William by George Douglas his attorney Complains that whereas the said Barnard on the fourth day of August Anno Domini MDCCLXXXIX at the County of Somerset did make his certain note in writing called a promissary note with the proper name and hand writing of the said Barnard signed and the said note to the said William then and there did deliver by which note the said Barnard did promise to pay to the said William the sum of three pounds fifteen Shillings to be paid in Indian Corn at twenty pence of Bushell at or before the first day of January then next ensuing the date of that note by means whereof and by force of the Statute in
