This day tovitt the 34 day of April 1741  
Came Capt<sup>r</sup> John Newbold in his proper  
person and made oath on the holi<sup>r</sup> Evangile  
of Almighty God that the above Account as it  
stands stated is just and true and that he never  
received part or percell of the above Acct more  
then credit given for <sup>dearly now</sup> satisfaction for the  
same — Sworn before Samuel Hopkins

A copy of the foregoing declaration was made and sent to be served on the Def<sup>r</sup> with the writ in the plena<sup>r</sup> —  
At which day here came the Capt<sup>r</sup> John Newbold by his attorney ap<sup>r</sup> and the sheriffe tovitt John Hand<sup>r</sup> gent<sup>r</sup> now here returnd<sup>r</sup>  
that he had taken the Capt<sup>r</sup> Paul Alexander whose body here at this day he had ready to answer the Capt<sup>r</sup> John Newbold of the Capt<sup>r</sup> plen<sup>r</sup>  
to him it was command<sup>r</sup> — And further the said sheriffe returned that he had servd the Capt<sup>r</sup> Paul Alexander with<sup>r</sup> copy of the  
foregoing declaration according to set of Assembly in such case made and provided<sup>r</sup> —

Whereupon came here into court a certain Nicholas Fountain of back Creek & Thomas Reyley both of Somerset  
Count<sup>r</sup> in their proper persons, and undertook and each of them undertook, for the said Paul Alexander & likewise the said Paul  
Alexander present here in court in his proper person, affirmed upon himself that if it should happen that Judgement in the plen<sup>r</sup>  
should be rendered for the same John, against the said Paul, or that he the said Paul should be therein convict, that then he the said  
Paul should pay and satisfie unto the said John, the Judgement of the court thereupon, or render his body in execution of such  
Judgement, to the prison of the sheriffe of the Count<sup>r</sup> ap<sup>r</sup>, in satisfaction thereof, or shall they the same Nicholas Fountain &  
Thomas Reyley will do the same for him<sup>r</sup> —

And the Capt<sup>r</sup> Paul Alexander by William Arwick<sup>r</sup> his attorney comes and defends the force and Injury wher<sup>r</sup>  
and saith that he cannot deny the action ap<sup>r</sup> of the Capt<sup>r</sup> John Newbold nor but that he did assume upon himself in manner  
form as the Capt<sup>r</sup> John above against him hath complained and as to the damage of the same John by him by Occasion of the  
premises in that part sustained the said John saith and acknowledgeth that the Capt<sup>r</sup> John hath sustained damages by  
Occasion of the premises beyond his costs and charges by him about his suit in this part apposed to three pounds fifteen  
shillings
