A copy of the foregoing Declaration was made and sent to be served on the deft. with the writ in a placard. At which day here came the afo. Levin Hale Esq^r. by his attorney

and the sheriffs to wit John Handy Gent: now here returned that he had taken the afo. Patrick Hervey whose body heretofore this day he had ready to answer the afo. Levin Hale Esq^r. of the afo. Plea as to him it was commanded. And further the same sheriffs returned that he served the afo. Patrick Hervey with a copy of the foregoing Declaration according to act of assembly in such case made and provided vsd.

Whereupon came hereinto court a certain Patrick Hervey Jr. of Somerset County planter in his proper person and undertook for the said Patrick Hervey Likewise the said Patrick Hervey present herein came in his proper person and affirmed upon himself that if it should happen that Judgment in the plea afo. should be rendered for the same Levin Hale against the afo.
