

Somerset County sh. Whereas it is made appear by sundry persons and particular by David Wilson that Terrall Brown Planter of Somerset County sh. is absconded from his place of former Residence and his Return Doubtfull if ever for many Reasons

These are therefore to Require you on sight hereof to Issue Attachment against the Goods and Chattles of the said Terrall Brown to the value of twenty four shillings and eight pence Curr: money with Cost agreeable to act of assembly in such cases provided and for so doing this shall be your warrant given under my hand this 28: day of May. Anno Domini 1741. . . . . Sam: Wilson.

In Obedience to the above warrant was Issued the following attachment against the goods and Chattles of the sh. Terrall Brown according to act of assembly in such cases made and provided &c. . . . .

Somerset sh. Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary of the provinces of maryland and a vallon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c. To the sheriffe of Somerset County greeting we Command you that you Attach any the goods Chattles rights or Credits of Terrall Brown late of Somerset County Planter if they shall be found in your bailiwick to the value of Twenty four shillings and eight pence Curr: money of maryland and four hundred pounds of tobacco and when you have the same attached or any part thereof the same in your Custody safe keep so that you have the same before our Justices of our County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of June Next then and there to be condemned according to act of assembly to and for the use of a certain David Wilson. Unless the said Terrall Brown by himself or his attorney shall appear and answer unto the said David Wilson of a plea of trespass upon this Case &c. according to Law and that by good and Lawfull men of your bailiwick you make known unto the person or persons in whose hands you make the same attachment that he she or they be and appear before our Justices of our County Court to be held as sh. to shew cause if and he she or they have why the same Goods Chattles rights or Credits so attached in his her or their hands ought not to be condemned and execution <sup>thereof</sup> had and made according to act of assembly in such cases made and provided if to him her or them it shall seem meet and how you shall execute this writ shall you make known unto our said Justices at the day and place sh. and have you then and there this writ Witness John Scott Gent: one of our Justices of our said Court the twenty fourth day of March Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and forty. . . . .

At which day here came the sh. David Wilson in his proper person and the sheriffe to wit John
