And as to the last plea of the *Ux.* Mary by her in manner and form *Ux.* pleaded the same William saith that he by any thing Breached from haveing his accou^{nt} *Ux.* against the said Mary to be precluded ought not because he says that the *Ux.* George in his life time within three years before the day of the Impetration of the writt Original of him the said William did assume upon himself in manner and form as the *Ux.* William above against the said Mary hath complained and this he prays may be Inquired of by the Country *Ux.* And the defendent in like manner.
