Attorneys afo^d. and hereupon the said William Ellegood declared against the afo^d. Heber Whittingham in the plea afo^d. In form following. & Somersel^s Heber Whittingham Late of Somersel County Inholder was attatched to answer unto William Ellegood of a plea of trespass upon the case &c.

And Whereupon the said William by George Douglas his attorney complains that whereas the said Heber after the first day of May anno Domini MDCCV to wit on the first day of July anno Domini MDCCXXVII at the County afo^d. did make his certain note in writing called a promissory with the proper hand of the said Heber. Subscribed and the said note to the said William Ellegood then and there did deliver by which note the said Heber did promise to pay the said William or his order the sum of forty pounds current money of Maryland by means whereof and by force of the statute in that case lately made and provided the said Heber became chargeable to pay to the said William the said forty pounds according to the tenor of that note and so being thereof chargeable the said Heber afterwards to wit the day and year last afo^d. at the County afo^d. in consideration thereof promised to pay the said forty pounds to the said William according to the tenor of that note. Nevertheless the said Heber his promise and assumption afo^d. informed afo^d. made not regarding but minding and fraudulently intending the said William in that part craftily and subtily to deceive and defraud the said forty pounds according to the tenor of the said note hath not paid or him for the same in any. or hitherto contented but that to do altogether hath refused and still doth refuse all his other afo^d. to wit on the first day of August in the year last afo^d. at the County afo^d. and often since that time by the said William required Whereupon the said William says he is damaged Sixty pounds Current money of Maryland and thereof he brings suit &c. —

William here also &c.
