Justices is newly put on whose name to the pannell within written is affixed according to the form of the statute in such case made and provided which said Juror so newly put on to wit Cornelius Beauvis being called likewise came who to say the truth of the premises ap. together with the other Jurors ap. first Impannelled and sworn being elected tryed and sworn upon their oath say that the aforesaid George Ruffe did a hunc upon himselfe in manner and form as the aforesaid Thomas Newt above against him hath complained and shewed the damages of the same -- Thomas by Deasion of the non performance of the promise and assumption aforesaid beyond his costs and Charges by him about his Suit in that part appoyed to Eleven pounds Curr. money of Maryland and for those Costs and Charges to One pound of Tobacco.

Therefore it is considered that the aforesaid Thomas Newt recover against the aforesaid George Ruffe in custody as aforesaid, his damages aforesaid, by the Jurors aforesaid, in full aforesaid ⁸³⁵ shewed, as also ⁸³⁶ Charges aforesaid, to the same Thomas by the Court now here of his assent of Increase adjudged, which certain damages in the whole amount to Eleven pounds Curr. money of Maryland and ⁸³⁶ pounds of Tobacco and the aforesaid Geo: in money &c.
