At which day here came again as well the afo^r Francis Allen as the afo^r John Evans by their Attorneys afo^r and hereupon

skill of the same Francis, in the management of the causes, suits, and business of his Clients afo^r, divers subjects of our Lord the
King and his predecessors the same Francis to be their Attorney, and their executors and suits in the Court afo^r, to prosecute and defend
duly did retain, by which the same Francis Attorneys fees, and other large sums of money for the management of their affairs
