I (the said himself meaning) fees in one cause (a certain suit wherein the ap^d Peter Taylor was plaintiff and the ap^d John
ap^d meaning) by pretext of the speaking and publishing the ap^d false feigned and scandalous words sundry of the clients
of him same Francis who him the same Francis before that time had retained to prosecute and defend divers causes and
suits in the ap^d County of Somerset here him the same Francis totally desert and leave, and him as their Attorney further to
retain or imply by Occasion thereof, utterly refuse by reason whereof divers Sums of money which from his clients ap^d he
might have lawfully and honestly acquired or may acquire he hath totally lost Whereupon the same Francis saith
he is damaged and damage hath to the value of five hundred pounds Curr. money of Maryland and thereof he brings suit

And the ap^d John Evans by George Douglas his Attorney comes and defends the force and Injury wherof and
prayeth leave thereof to imparle here untill next Court to be he held at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of June then next
following and he hath it and the same day is given to the ap^d Francis here also

At which day here came again as well the ap^d Francis Allen as the ap^d John Evans by their Attorney ap^d and
thereupon the said John Evans saith that he cannot deny the action aforesaid of the aforesaid Francis
Allen nor can he say but that he speak the words of the ap^d Francis in the declaration ap^d mentioned, and
the same John acknowledged that the same words were false, and further the same John says that the
said Francis ought to recover his damages by Occasion of the speaking and uttering of the words aforesaid
beyond his costs and Charges by him about his suit in this part expended
to Twenty pounds Currant Money of Maryland and not more and because the aforesaid Francis
denys not this but the same allegation grants to be true prays Judgment for those damages ap^d
above acknowledged together with his costs and Charges aforesaid to him to be adjudged

Whereupon the aforesaid Francis freely here in Court remitteth unto the aforesaid John the ap^d
Twenty pounds Curr. money of Maryland his damages ap^d by the ap^d John in form ap^d acknowledged
Therefore the same John of the aforesaid Twenty pounds be thereof quiet

Therefore it is considered that the aforesaid Francis Allen recover against the ap^d John Evans
the aforesaid Twenty pounds Curr. money of Maryland his damages aforesaid in form ap^d acknowledged as
also three hundred and ninety three pounds of tobacco for his costs and Charges
aforesaid to the same Francis by the Court here of his ap^d adjudged and the ap^d John in Merry
