John deny not this but the same allegation grants to be true prays Judgment for those damages above acknowledged together with his Costs and Charges af. to him to be adjudged &c.

Therefore by Consent of the parties af. it is Considered that the af. John Newbold recover against the af. Joarib Field his damages af. to the af. ten pounds four shillings and Eleven pence Curr. paper money of Maryland by the same Joarib in form af. acknowledged as also:
