Comin and was given to the sherriff of Somerset County that pro show
 Ch. Archibald Mc Neal ... take Archibald Mc Neal late of Somerset County joyner if he should be found
 in his baileywick and him should vys keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of this
 Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Bridgwater the third tuesday of November anno
 Domini thousand seven hundred and forty to answer unto John Wildman of a plea of her pase upon
 the case &c and the same day is given to the Ch. John here &c.

At which day here came the Ch. John Wildman by Francis Allen his attorney and the
 Sherriff to witness John Flandy gent: nowhere remained that he had taken the Ch. Archibald Mc Neal
 whose body hereat this day he had ready to answer the Ch. John Wildman of the said plea as to him
 it was comanded. And hereupon the said John Wildman declared against the Ch.
 Archibald Mc Neal in the plea as in form following. Somerset County vs. Archibald Mc Neal late
 of Somerset County joyner was attatched to answer unto John Wildman of a plea of her pase upon the
 case &c. And whereupon the said John by Francis Allen his attorney complains that
 whereas the said Archibald the thirtieth day of August anno Domini seventeen hundred and forty at
 the County Ch. within the jurisdiction of this court was indebted unto the said John in fifty one pounds
 and eight pence half penny curr. money of maryland for sundry properly chargeable in account as
 by account thereon hereunto annexed may in Court appear and being so thredy indebted the said
 Archibald in consideration thereof the day and year aforesaid at the County Ch. upon himself did assume
 and to the said John then and there did faithfully promise that he the said Archibald the Ch.
 eighty one pounds and eight pence half penny to the said John when he should be afterwards
 therunto requested he would well and faithfully pay and content and altho the said Archibald
 fiftieen pounds fourteen shillings and six pence parcell of the Ch. eighty one pounds and eight
 pence half penny to the said John he hath paid and satisfied yett as to thirty six pounds six
 shillings and two pence half penny residue of the Ch. eighty one pounds and eight pence half
 penny the said Archibald his promise and assumption aforesaid in anywise made nothing regarding
 but plotting and fraudulently intending the said John in that part basly and ably to
 decive and defraud the Ch. thirty six pounds six shillings and two pence half penny to the said
 John hath not paid or contented alia the same to do the Ch. Archibald by the said John on the
 Ch. thirtieth day of August in the year aforesaid and often afterwards at the County Ch. he was
 therunto requested but the same to him helpe to pay or content hath refused and still doth
 refuse and deny Whereupon the said John saith he is wrong and hath damage to the
 value of Seventy pounds curr. money of maryland and thereof he brings suit.
