the said John should pay the said sum to the said Archibald in full of all accounts between the said parties before the submission apd: and this he is ready to verify Whereupon he prayes Judgment of the said John his action aſt against him to have and maintain ought.

And the said John with that he by any thing by the said Archibald above in his plea alledged from having his action apd: against him the said Archibald to be foreclosed ought not because he with that he the said John, never accounted with him the said Archibald in manner and form as the said Archibald above in pleading hath alledged for all sums of money due from the said Archibald to the said John so nor did the said John at the day in the said plea mentioned nor at any other time submitt all matters of account which he had against the said Archibald to James Martin Gent: in the said Plea mentioned in manner and form as the said Archibald above in his plea aſt hath alledged and this he prayes may be inquired of by the Country &c.

And afterwards the said John Wildman by his attorney apd: the same day and year last apd: mentioned there and there his wife apd: against the apd: Archibald Mr: Neal did not prosecute with effect but voluntarly suffered his suit to be discontinued.

Therefore afterwards to with the same day by discretion of the Justices here were.

Adjudged the same Archibald Mr: Neal:

282 for his costs and charges by him about his defense in this part sustained according to the form of the statute in such case lately made and provided and the apd: John Wildman in mercy and the apd: Archibald Mr: Neal have thereof Execution &c.

At: Elias Evans

Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take Peter Taylor late if he should be found in his bailiwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of March anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and forty to answer unto Elias Evans of a plea of trespass upon the case & and the same day is given to the apd: Elias here &c.

At which day here came the apd: Elias Evans by Francis Allen his attorney and the sheriff to with John Hanby Gent: who here returned that he had taken the apd: Peter Taylor whose body here at this day he had ready to answer the apd: Elias Evans of the apd: plea as to him it was commanded.

And hereupon the said Elias Evans declared against the apd: Peter Taylor in the plea aſt in form following Somerset þ Peter Taylor late of Somerset County planter was attached to answer unto Elias Evans of a plea of trespass upon the case &c.
