shillings and eight pence to the said Elias he hath not paid or contented altho' the same to do the aforesaid Peter by the said Elias on the first
day of November in the year aforesaid often afterwards at the County aforesaid he was thereto requested but the same to him hitherto to
pay or content hath refused and still doth refuse and deny whereupon the said Elias saith he is worse and hath damage to the

list of Almighty God that the above aet^t is just and true and that he never received any part or parcell satisfaction or credit more then

Whereupon at the prayer of the aforesaid Elias Evans the aforesaid Peter Taylor is adjudged to give speciall bail to the action aforesaid
Thereupon came herraunto Court a certain William Fleming late of Somerset County aforesaid and understood for the said Peter Taylor
Likewise the said Peter Taylor present herein Court in his proper person assumed upon himself that if it should happen that
Judgment in the plen^a aforesaid should be rendered for the same Elias Evans against the aforesaid Peter Taylor or that the same Peter Taylor
should be therein Conviect that then he the same Peter Taylor should pay and satisfy unto the said Elias Evans the Judgment of
the Court thereupon or render his body in Execution of such Judgment to the prison of the sheriff of the County aforesaid in satisfaction
hereof or that he the same William Fleming will do the same for him &c

And the aforesaid Peter Taylor by George Douglas his attorney came and defends the force and Injury whereto and prayeth
leave thereof to Imparle here untill next Court to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of June then next following and he
hath it and the same day is given to the aforesaid Elias herein also &c

At which day here came again as well the aforesaid Elias Evans as the aforesaid Peter Taylor by their Attorneys aforesaid and
whereupon the said Peter saith that he cannot deny the action aforesaid of the aforesaid Elias Evans nor but that he did assume upon
himself in manner and form as the aforesaid Elias Evans above against him hath complained and as to the damage of the same Elias by
