Therefore he and his pledges of prosecuting are in mercy and let the said Seward Tomlinson name pledged and that the aforesaid Francis Henderson goe thereof without day also it is considered that the aforesaid Francis Henderson recover against the aforesaid Seward Tomlinson his damages by Occasion of the premises to: pounds of tobacco to the same Francis by discretion of the Justices here at his request for his Costs and Charges in that part sustained according to the form of the statute in such Case lately made and provided by the Court he adjudged &c.
