which saffre fone again the partye by their attorneyes and herewpon the said William complained
against the aſt. Francis in the plea aſt. in form following — Somerset ſt. Francis late late of Somerset County —
Glanter was attached to answer unto William Jones of Nescongo of a plea of trespass upon the case &c

And Whereupon the same William by Robert Jenkins Henry his attorney complaineth that whereas
the aforesaid Francis the eighteenth day of february in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and
thirty nine at Somerset County aforesaid was indebted unto the same William in the sum of three hundred
Six shillings one penny and the half of one penny Current money of Maryland for three hundred
eighty and nine pounds of pence by the aforesaid Francis of the same William before that time bought
had and received as by an account thereof hereinto brought may appear and so thereaff.

Debted being the afo. Francis afterwards to with the same day and year afo: at the County afo.
in Consideration thereof upon himself did assume and to the same William then and therewithfully
promise that he the afo. Francis the said sum of three pounds six shillings one penny and one half
penny unto the same William when thereof afterwards requoted would well and faithfully pay
and content and altho the afo. Francis ten shillings and six pence part of the afo. sum of three
pounds six shillings one penny and the half of one penny unto the same William hali since
paid and satisfied Nevertheless the afo. Francis at two pounds fifteen shillings seven
pence and one half penny of the afo. three pounds six shillings and one penny half penny
residue his promise and assumption afo: in form afo: made not regarding but intending and
frankly intending the same William in this part part craftily and subtilly to deceare and
defraude the said sum of two pounds fifteen shillings and seven pence half penny unto the said
William he hath not paid or him for the same in any sort contented altho the same to do the afo.

Francis afterwards to with the same day and year above mentioned and often since that time at
Somerset County affd by the same William was requested but the same to pay or in any
way contented the said Francis hath hether to altogether refused and still doth refuse whereupon
the same William says that he is worse and hath damage to the value of seven pounds fifteen money
of Maryland and thereof he brings suit & Bledges y^r g^t Doe and R^r Rose
