R. H. & T. William Scott - Command was given to the sheriff of Somersel County that he should take Joshua Sturgis  
Qd. W. T. Joshua Sturgis. Sturgis late of Somersel County planter if he should be found in his bailywick and him  
should also keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court  
of Somersel to be held at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of June Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and forty  
two to answer unto William Scott of a plea of trespass upon the last y<sup>r</sup> and the same day is given to the Esq<sup>r</sup>. William  
here Esq<sup>r</sup>. . . . At which day here came the Esq<sup>r</sup>. William Scott by Robert Jenchins Henry his attorney and the  
Sheriff to witness John Henry gent<sup>r</sup> now here returned that he had taken the Esq<sup>r</sup>. Joshua Sturgis whose body  
hereat this day he had ready to answer the Esq<sup>r</sup>. William Scott of the Esq<sup>r</sup>. plea as to him it was commanded.

Whereupon the said Joshua Sturgis puts in his place George Douglas gent<sup>r</sup> attorney at Law against the  
Esq<sup>r</sup>. William Scott of the Esq<sup>r</sup>. plea. . . And whereupon at the request of the parties Esq<sup>r</sup>. Day is to them now here  
given until next Court to be held at dividing Creek in and for the County of the said Tuesday of August then next  
following in the same stals as at present subsisting to the parties Esq<sup>r</sup>. y<sup>r</sup>.

All which day here came again the parties Esq<sup>r</sup>. by their attorneys Esq<sup>r</sup>. and hereupon the said William Scott complained  
against the Esq<sup>r</sup>. Joshua Sturgis in the plea Esq<sup>r</sup>. in form following. . . Somersel Esq<sup>r</sup>. Joshua Sturgis late of Somersel  
County Planter was attached to answer unto William Scott of a plea of trespass upon the last y<sup>r</sup>.

And Whereupon the same William by Robert Jenchins Henry his attorney complains that whereas the Esq<sup>r</sup>. Joshua  
the thirtieth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred thirty and nine at Somersel County Esq<sup>r</sup>. was indebted  
to the same William in the sum of twenty and one pounds curr<sup>t</sup> money of Maryland for sundry articles proper  
in
