Therefore by consent of the parties a^o it is Considered that the a^o John Hilbee recover against the a^o William King his damages a^o to the a^o five pounds Eleven shillings and Six pence Currant money by the same William in form a^o Acknowledged as a^o ~~Two hundred thirty Two~~ ^{Two hundred thirty Two} pounds of tobacco for his Costs and Charges a^o to the same John at his request by the Court now here of the a^o of the parties a^o adjudged which certain damages in the whole Amounts to five pounds Eleven shillings and Six pence Currant money and: ~~Two hundred & thirty Two~~ ^{Two hundred & thirty Two} pounds of tobacco and the a^o William in mercy &
