Whereupon came here into Court the afo^rd Joseph Lewis in his proper person and undertook for the said Rachel Barne and acknowledged himselfe Indebted unto his said Lordship the Lord Proprietary of Maryland in twenty pounds (and money of the province of his body goods or Chattels Lands or tenements to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and successors to be made and Levied If it happen that the said Rachel Barne do not make her personall appearance before his said Lordships Justices at the next Court to be held at dividing Creek the the Third Tuesday of November then next following and doe not then and there give such Evidence as she shall know on behalfe of his said Lordship against the afo^rd Gammage Evans and that she do depart the same Court without leave &c

The same | Sommerv^r Memorandum That at a seshion of the peace of his Lordships the Right Honourable Francis Tal^e. the Lord Proprietary of the Province of Maryland held at dividing Creek in the County aff^t the third Tuesday of March to witt the seventeenth day of the same Anno Domini One thousand seven hundred and forty before his said Lordships Justices the peace in the County aff^t to keep apnised by the Oath of Twelve Jurors presented that Francis Tale of Stepney parish for selling of Liquor without Licence which he had done for some time and in the month of February last did sell to John Shuckley one q^t of Rum and did demand and receive for the same one bushell of Indian Corn —

By which it was commanded the Sheriff of the County aforesaid that he should take the said Francis Tale if he to answer & and afterward to witt the same day and year abovesaid before his said Lordships Justices at a seshion held at dividing Creek in and for the County aforesaid come the said Francis Tale in his proper person. And thereupon the said Francis Tale is Ordered by the Court here to give security for his appearance at the next Court to be held at dividing Creek in and for the County aff^t the third Tuesday of June then next following to answer unto the presentment aforesaid & but for want thereof the said Francis Tale is committed into the custody of the Sheriff of the County aff^t there to remain until he shall be from thence delivered by due Course of Law.

At which said third Tuesday of June Anno Domini One thousand seven hundred and forty one delivered by due Course of Law the aforesaid Francis Tale at a seshion held at dividing Creek by his said Lordships Justices came the afo^rd Francis Tale in his proper person in custody of the Sheriff of the County aff^t in whose custody for the cause aforesaid was committed and being by the said Sheriff led to the Barr in thereupon instantly Ordered to give security for his appearance at the next Court to be held at dividing Creek in and for the County aff^t the third Tuesday of August then next following to answer unto the presentment aforesaid but for want thereof the said Francis Tale is committed into the custody of the Sheriff of the County aff^t there to remain until he be from thence delivered by due Course of Law —

At which said third Tuesday of August Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and forty one at a Court then held at dividing Creek by his said Lordships Justices came the afo^rd Francis Tale in his proper person in custody of the Sheriff of the County aff^t in whose custody for the cause aforesaid was committed and being by the said Sheriff led to the Barr and had a hearing of the presentmt
