in ten poundes Sterling money each of their bodys goods or Challes Lands or tenements severally to be made and Levied  
to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors If it happen that the said Katherine Wilman do not make  
her personall appearance at the next Court to be held at diwidng Creek the third Tuesday of June then next following  
to answer unto his said Lordship of the Inditment <sup>and</sup> and do not stay and abide the Judgment of the Court thereupon  
and do depart the same Court without Leave and in the mean time if she be not of the good behaviour <sup>the</sup> —

All which day here before his Lordships Iustices came the aforesaid Katherine Wilman in her proper person
