Therefore by Consent of the parties afd: it is Considered that the afd: William Jones Recover against the afd: Francis Six his damages afd: to the afd: two pounds fifteen Shillings and seven pence and one half penny Curr: money: and also three hundred and fifty nine pounds of tobacco for his Costs and Charges afd: to the same Wm at his request by the Court now here of the afd: of the parties afd: Adjudged which certain damages in the whole amounts to two pounds fifteen Shillings and seven pence and one half penny Curr: money and three hundred and fifty nine pounds of tobacco and the afd: Francis in mercy &
