Whereupon all and singular the premises being seen and by the Court here fully understood It is Considered by the Court here that the aforesaid Absolom Hobbs pay unto his Lordship the Right Honorable the Lord Proprietary of Maryland for his fine by the Court hereupon him Imposed for and by Occasion of the premises aforesaid whereof in forme aforesaid he is Convict thirty shillings Court money of Maryland and that the said Absolom Hobbs be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of the fine aforesaid

Whereupon the said Absolom Hobbs is Ordered to give security to save and keep Indemnified the Justices of the County of Somerset and their Successors from all troubles burthens and Charges that might Accrew by means of the birth and maintainance and bringing up of the Child aforesaid

Thereupon the said Absolom Hobbs with George Dashiell of Somerset County Gent. his Security present here in Court in his proper person Acknowledged themselves Indebted unto his Lordship the right Honourable the Lord Proprietary of the province of Maryland in twenty pounds Court money of their Body goods or Chattels lands or tenements severally to be made and Levied to the use of the Inhabitants of the County of Somerset for the time being. If it happen that the said Absolom Hobbs & George Dashiell their heirs Executors and Administrators or any or either of them, doe not, from time to time, & at all times hereafter acquit discharge and save harmless as well the Justices of Somerset County Court for the time being, as also the Inhabitants of said County, of and from all Cost Charges, and burthens, what soever for or by reason of the birth maintainance, nourishing and bringing up of the said Child, and of and from all other suits Charges, troubles, and demands what soever touching or Concerning of the same

The Same -- Somerset County p. Be it remembered that Robert Jenekins Henry Gentleman -- Thomas Singelly - attorney of the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary that now is who for the said Lord

Proprietary in this part prosecuteth doth come here into the County Court of the said Lord Proprietary held for Somerset County aforesaid to witt at Dwiding Creek in the same County the Eighteenth day of August in the Year of Our Lord God One thousand seven hundred and forty One before Robert King Esquire and his associates the said Lord Proprietary his Justices of the same County Court and for the same Lord Proprietary doth give the same Justices to understand and be informed that Thomas Singelly late of Allhallows Parish in the said County of Somerset Blantir the tenth day of July in the year of our Lord God Seventeen hundred and forty one with force and arms &c. at the parish aforesaid in the County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court in and upon a certain Benton Harris then and still being Sub Sheriff to John Handy Gent. high Sheriff of the said County of Somerset duly qualified and sworn and in the due execution of his office in the peace of God and the said Lord Proprietary that now is then and there being an assault did make and him the said Benton Harris in the execution of his said Office aforesaid then and there did beat wound and evilly treat so that of his Life it was greatly impaired and other harms to the same Benton then and there did to the grievous damage of him the said Benton and Contrary to the peace of the right Honourable the Lord Proprietary that now is his good Rules and Government
