afo John altho often requested the said Ninety five pounds Eight Shillings and Sixpence Sterling unto the same Philip hath
not as yet paid but the same to him he hetherto to pay hath refused and still doth refuse to the damage of the same Philip one
hundred pounds Sterling and thereupon he brings Suit &c

And the afo John Fleming by George Douglas his Attorney cometh and defendeth the force and Injury whereto and
saith that he cannot deny the action afo of the afo Philip & nor can he say but that the writing obligatory afo is the act of the same
John nor can he say but that he owes the same Philip the afo Ninety five pounds Eight Shillings and Sixpence Sterling in
manner and form as the afo Philip above against him hath declared

There fore it is considered that the afo Philip & recover against the afo Peter Taylor his debt afo & his
damages by occasion of the detention of the same debt to:

275 : pounds of tobacco to the same Philip or his Agent by the Court here adjudged and the afo Peter in recompense

to be held and firmly bound to the same Robert in the afo sum of eighty pounds to be paid to the
same Robert when he should be thereto Afterwards Required Nevertheless the afo Nathaniel
the afo sum of eighty pounds altho by the same Robert often Required hath not paid but the same
to pay hath altogether Refused and still doth Refuse Whereupon the same Robert saith he is
Dannified
