And the Asd. Nathaniel Jackson by George Douglas his attorney cometh and
saith the force and injury when ^{vs} and saith that he cannot deny the action of the
Asd. Robert Allan nor can he say but that this writing ^{Obligatory} Asd. is the deed of the same Nathaniel.
nor can he say but that he owes the same Robert the Asd. Eighty pounds curr. money of Virginia
of the value of One hundred and twenty pounds curr. money of Maryland in manner and
form as the Asd. Robert above against him hath declared.

Therefore it is considered that the Asd. Robert Allan Recover against the
Asd. Nathaniel Jackson his debt Asd. and his damages by occasion of the detencion of the same
Debt to

Bottles of tobacco to the same Robert of
his Agent by the court here adjudged and the Asd. Nathaniel in Mercy ^{vs} And afterward to wit
the eighteenth day of August Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and forty one came herein
Court the Asd. Nathaniel Jackson in his proper person and being asked if he was the same person
the same Nathaniel against whom the above Judgment was Recovered acknowledged he was and
thereupon the said Nathaniel is committed to the prison of the sheriff of the County Asd. there to remain
until the Asd. Robert Allan of the debt and damages Asd. should be fully satisfied the said Sheriff
to wit John Hande gentl. present herein Court in his proper person took Charge of the said Nathaniel
accordingly ^{vs}.

Wit the same Somerset Esq; Nathaniel Jackson late of Somerset County planter otherwise called Nathaniel Jackson of
Asd. The Same. Somerset County Maryland was summoned to Answer unto Robert Allen of a plea that he render unto him twenty
pounds curr. money of Virginia of the value of forty pounds curr. money of Maryland which to him he does
and unjustly detains ^{vs} And Whereupon the same Robert by William Arbuckle his Attorney says that whereas the Asd.
Nathaniel the fifth day of March Anno Domini seventeen hundred and forty one by his certain writing obligatory which the
same Robert sealed with the seal of the Asd. Nathaniel ^{vs} here into Court brings whose date is the day and year asd. Acknowledges
himself to be held and firmly bound to the same Robert in the Asd. sum of twenty pounds curr. money of Virginia to be paid
to the same Robert when he should be thereto afterwards required Nevertheless the Asd. Nathaniel (alio) often required the Asd.
sum to the same Robert hath not as yet paid but the same to pay hath hitherto altogether refused and still doth refuse Wherupon,
the same Robert saith he is damaged and damage hath to the value of forty five pounds curr. money of Maryland and therof
