And the said Nathaniel Jackson by George Douglas his attorney Cometh and defendeth the force and Injury when &c. and saith that he cannot deny the action of the said Robert Allan nor can he say but that the writing <sup>obligatory</sup> of the said Nathaniel nor can he say but that he owes the same Robert the said Eighty pounds Curr: money of Virginia of the value of One hundred and twenty pounds Curr: money of Maryland in manner and form as the said Robert above against him hath declared . . . . .

Therefore it is considered that the said Robert Allan Recover against the said Nathaniel Jackson his debt of &c. and his damages by occasion of the detention of the same Debt to &c. of tobacco to the same Robert of his Assent by the Court here adjudged and the said Nathaniel in Mercy &c. And afterwards to wit the eighteenth day of August Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and forty one came here into Court the said Nathaniel Jackson in his proper person and being asked if he was the same person the same Nathaniel against whom the above Judgment was Recovered acknowledged he was and thereupon the said Nathaniel is committed to the prison of the Sheriff of the County of &c. there to remain untill the said Robert Allan of the debt and damages of &c. should be fully satisfied the said Sheriff to wit John Handy Gent: present herein Court in his proper person took charge of the said Nathaniel accordingly &c.

Wit The Same Somerset s/ Nathaniel Jackson late of Somerset County planter otherwise called Nathaniel Jackson of Somerset County Maryland was summoned to answer unto Robert Allen of a plea that he render unto him twenty pounds Curr: money of Virginia of the value of forty pounds Curr: money of Maryland which to him he owes and unjustly detains &c. And whereupon the same Robert by William Arbuckle his Attorney says that whereas the said Nathaniel the fifth day of March Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and forty forty one by his certain writing obligatory which the same Robert sealed with the seal of the said Nathaniel ~~was~~ here into Court brings whose date is the day and year aforesaid Acknowledged himself to be held and firmly bound to the same Robert in the said Sum of twenty pounds Curr: money of Virginia to be paid to the same Robert when he should be thereto afterwards required Nevertheless the said Nathaniel (altho: often required) the said Sum to the same Robert hath not as yet paid but the same to pay hath hitherto altogether refused and still doth refuse Whereupon the same Robert saith he is damni~~fy~~ and damage hath to the value of forty five pounds Curr: money of Maryland and thereof he brings
