Somerset spt. Charles Revell late of Somerset County planter otherwise called Charles Roavel of
Somerset County in the province of, was summoned to answer unto Littleton Townend administrator
with the will annexed of all and singular the goods and chattels which were of Job Sherry dec'd at the time of
his death of a plea that he render unto him fifteen thousand and fifty six pounds of tobacco which from
him he unjustly detain'd.

And Whereupon the said Littleton by his attorney says that whereas
the said Charles on the twelfth day of October anno Domini MDCCXXXIIJ at the County aforesaid by his certain
writing Obligatory which the said Littleton sealed with the seal of the said Charles hereinto brought
whose date is the same day and year last mentioned did acknowledge himself to be hold and firmly
bound unto the said Job Sherry in his Lifetime in the said sum of fifteen thousand and fifty six pounds
of tobacco to be paid to the said Job Sherry his heirs Executors Administrators or assigns or L. & C. &c.
Attorney when he the said Charles should afterwards be thereto required and to the payment of the
said sum of tobacco did bind himself his heirs Executors by the said writing Obligatory Neverthelesso
the said Charles the said fifteen thousand and fifty six pounds of tobacco to the said Job Sherry in his
Lifetime or to the said Littleton since the death of the said Job Sherry hath not rendered but that same
to his said Job in his Lifetime or to the said Littleton since the death of the said Job to render hath done
and the same to the said Littleton to render still doth deny and unjustly detain altho' the same to the said
Job in his Lifetime to render the said Charles afterwards to wit the day and year last aforesaid at the County
aforesaid often since that time was required and altho' the said Charles the same to the said Littleton
since the death of the said Job to render afterwards to wit on the tenth day of August anno Domini
MDCCXXXIX at the County aforesaid and often since that time was required Whereupon the said
Littleton says he is damaged sixteen thousand pounds of tobacco and thereof he brings suit and the
said Littleton brings into Court the Letters of Administration by which he

All which day here came the aforesaid Littleton Townend by his attorney and the sheriff to wit John Henry Gent now
here returned that he had taken the aforesaid Charles Revell whose body here at this day he had ready to answer the aforesaid Littleton
Townend of the aforesaid plea as to him it was commanded.

Whereupon the aforesaid Charles Revell at the prayer of the aforesaid Littleton Townend is adjudged to give speciall Bail to
the action aforesaid

Theerupon came here into Court a certain Robert King of Somerset County Gent in his proper person
and undertook for the said Charles Revell likewise the said Charles Revell present here in Court in his proper person Assumed
upon himself) that if it should happen that Judgment in the plea aforesaid should be rendered for the same Littleton against the
aforesaid
