All which day here came againe as well the *Asse.* Francis Allen as the *Asse.* Peter Taylor by their attorneys *Asse.* And whereupon the said Peter Taylor as before defends the foresaid injury when *Asse.* and say that the said Francis his accion *Asse.* thereof against him to have ought maintain ought not because he says that at the time when the English words in the declaration mentioned were supposed to be spoken and published by the said Peter did speak and relate of the said Francis these English words following if he speaking of the said Francis has charged John Evans the same fees ^{that} he has charged me he hath taken double fees without that that the said Peter speaks and published of the said Francis the *Asse.* English words in the declaration of the said Francis above specified to with Francis Allen hath taken double fees one from John Evans another from me in one and the same cause as the said Francis by his declaration *Asse.* above supposes and this he is ready to verify wherefore he prays Judgment if the said Francis his accion *Asse.* against him to have ought *Asse.*

And hereupon the said Francis Allen prays Leave thereof to Imparts here untill next Court to be holden dividing week in and for the County *Asse.* the third tuesday of August then next following and he hath it and the same day is given to the *Asse.* Peter Taylor here also *Asse.*

All which day here came againe as well the *Asse.* Francis Allen as the *Asse.* Peter Taylor, ^{by their attorneys of} And whereupon the said Peter Taylor Relinquisheth his Verification, by him above alleged and saith that he cannot deny the action *Asse.* of the *Asse.* Francis Allen, nor can he say but that he the said Peter speak the words of the *Asse.* Francis in the declaration *Asse.* mentioned, nor can he say but that the said Francis ought to recover ^{his} damages by occasion of the speaking and uttering of the words *Asse.* beyond his costs and charges by him about his suit in this part expended to twenty pounds curr. money of maryland and not more and because the *Asse.* Francis deny not this but the same allegations granted to be true prays Judgment for those damages *Asse.* above acknowledged together with his costs and charges *Asse.* to him to be adjudged

Whereupon the *Asse.* Francis Allen freely herein Court Remitteth unto the *Asse.* Peter the *Asse.* Twenty pounds curr. money of maryland the damages *Asse.* by the *Asse.* Peter in form *Asse.* acknowledged therefore the same Peter of the *Asse.* Twenty pounds be thereof quiet *Asse.*

Therefore it is considered that the *Asse.* Francis Allen Recover against the *Asse.* Peter Taylor the *Asse.* Twenty Pound curr. money of maryland his damages *Asse.* in form *Asse.* acknowledged as also *Asse.*
