Somerset Memorandum That on the 13th day of December Ann^d Dom^o 1740 Came James Johnson and John Paterson before us two of his Lordships Justices of the peace for Somerset County and made Oath on the Holy Evangelist of Almighty God that the within Account against Jarvis Ballard as it stands stated is Just and true and that the severall Articles were delivered by them Either together or by one of them from the Other Except ^{the} two last articles of said Account and that they never received part or percell thereof more then Credits is given for Sworn before Geo: Dashiell

And the ap^l Jarvis Ballard by his Attorney ap^l Comes and defends the force and Injury when ^{he} and prayeth leave thereof to Impart here untill next Court to be held at dividing Creek in and for the County ap^l the third Tuesday of June then next following and he hath it and the same day is given to the ap^l James here also ^{Sam^l Hopkins}

At which day here came again aswell the ap^l James Johnson as the ap^l Jarvis Ballard by their Attorneys ap^l. And Whereupon the parties aforesaid by their said Attorneys Submitted their dispute in this action to the arbitrament & final determination of George Gale and Samuel Wilson of Somerset County Gentlemen and it is agreed by and between the parties aforesaid that the aforesaid Arbitrators Return their arbitrament in Writing under their hands and seals to the Justice of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing Creek in and for the County ap^l the third Tuesday of August then next following that the same Justice may proceed thereon to Judgment against either of the parties ap^l as if the Cause were determined by the Court. And it is further agreed by their parties ap^l by their Attorneys aforesaid that that Submission aforesaid be made a rule of this Court Therefore it is Ordered that the Submission aforesaid in manner and form ap^l made according to the form and Effect of the Statute in that Case lately made and provided be Entered and made a rule of this Court on the motion of the parties ap^l by their Attorneys ap^l. and the same day is given to the parties ap^l here Ver

In which day here came again the parties aforesaid by their Attorneys aforesaid and here upon George Gale and Samuel Wilson the Gentlemen mentioned in the above rule of Submission Likewise came and made Return of their arbitrament in the premises ap^l between the parties aforesaid in manner following. Pursuant to the Submission of James Johnson ap^l and Jarvis Ballard def^t to us Submitted we doe award that the ap^l Jarvis Ballard pay to the said James Twelve pounds of Tobacco and five pounds ten Shillings current money of Maryland And that the said James Johnson pay to the said Jarvis Ballard his full Costs in the Suit Given under our hands this 26th day of August 1741 Geo. Gale

Jonathan Throckley } Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should Take Jonathan Throckley late of Somerset County planter if he should be found in his bailiwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of November Ann^d Dom^o one thousand seven hundred and forty to answer unto Francis Tate of a plea of trespass upon the Case &c and the same day is given to the ap^l Francis here &c.
