A copy of the foregoing declaration was made and sent to be served on the defendant in order for a speedy Tryall.

At which day here came the ^{defd.} David Wilson by his attorney ^{esq.} and the sheriff to wit John Standish Gent. now here returned that he had taken the ^{defd.} Heber Whittingham whose body hereat this day he had ready to answer the ^{defd.} David of the ^{defd.} pleasure to him it was commanded and further the same sheriff returned that he had sent the ^{defd.} Heber Whittingham with a copy of the foregoing declaration according to act of assembly in such case lately made and provided ^{be it}.

And the ^{defd.} Heber Whittingham by William Arbuckle his attorney comes and defends the force and Injury where ^{be} and prays leave thereof to Impark here until the next court to be held addividing in and for the County ^{esq.} the third Tuesday of August then next following and he hath it and the same day is given to the ^{defd.} David here also.

At which day here came againe as well the ^{defd.} David Wilson as the ^{defd.} Heber Whittingham by their attorney ^{esq.} and hereupon the said Heber as before defends the force and Injury where ^{be} and saith that he cannot deny the action ^{esq.} of the ^{defd.} David Wilson nor but that he did assume upon himself in manner and form ^{as} ^{the} ^{defd.} David above above against him hath complained and as to the damage of the same David by him by occasion of the premises in that part sustained the same Heber Whittingham saith and acknowledgeth that the ^{defd.} David hath sustained damages by occasion of the premises beyond his costs and charges by him about his suit in that part appos'd to Twenty - two pounds thirteen shillings and one penny Current money of the Province of Maryland and not more and because the ^{defd.} David deny not this but the same allegation grants to be true foray Judgment for those damages above acknowledged together with his costs and charges to him to be adjudged ^{be}.

Therefore by consent of the parties ^{esq.} it is considered that the ^{defd.} David Wilson Recover against the ^{defd.} Heber Whittingham his damages ^{esq.} to the ^{defd.} Twenty pounds thirteen shillings and one penny - Current money of the province ^{esq.} in manner and form ^{esq.} acknowledged as also four hundred and fourteen pounds of tobacco for his costs and charges ^{esq.} to the same David at his request by the court now here off the absent of the parties ^{esq.} adjudged which certain damages in the whole amount to Fifteen pounds thirteen shillings and one penny - Current money of the province ^{esq.} and four hundred and fourteen pounds of tobacco and the ^{defd.} Heber in money ^{be} Memorandum the poynt Relaweth twenty shillings Current money ^{esq.} out of the above damages ^{be}.
