The said James Townsend or that he the same James should be there in Court that then he the same James should pay and satisfy unto the said Robert Geddes the Judgment of the Court thereupon or render his Body in Execution of such Judgment to the prison of the Sheriff of the County of in Satisfaction thereof or that he the same John Townsend will do the same for him & — And the aforesaid James Townsend by Robert Jenkins Henry his Attorney comes and defends the force and Injury wherein & And pray leave thereunto Imparte here untill next Court to be held at dividing Creek in and for the County af. the third Tuesday of June then next following and he hath it and the same day is given to the aforesaid Robert here also & —

At which day here came again as well the aforesaid Robert Geddes as the aforesaid James Townsend by their Attorneys aforesaid and whereupon the said James as before defends the force and Injury wherein & And says that he is not indebted to the aforesaid Robert Geddes the aforesaid sum of thirty five pounds Current money and three hundred thirty eight pounds of Merchantable Tobacco or any part of the said money or tobacco in form of in which the same Robert Geddes above against him hath declared and of this he puts himself upon the Country & —

And hereupon the said Robert Geddes prays leave thereunto Imparte here untill next Court to be held at dividing Creek in and for the County af. the third Tuesday of August then next following and he hath it and the same day is given to the aforesaid James here also & —

At which day here came again as well the aforesaid Robert Geddes as the aforesaid James Townsend by their Attorneys aforesaid and whereupon the said James Relinquisheth his Verification aforesaid by him above alleged sayth that he cannot deny the action aforesaid of the aforesaid Robert Geddes nor but that he owes the same Robert the aforesaid thirty five pounds Current money of Maryland and three hundred and thirty eight pounds of Merchantable Tobacco in manner and form as the aforesaid Robert above against him hath declared --

Therefore it is considered that the aforesaid Robert Geddes Recover against the aforesaid James Townsend his debt aforesaid and his damages by Occasion of the detention of the same debt to the aforesaid James in every Memoran^m the plaintiff release out of the above debt.

Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take John Waller late of Somerset County planter if he should be found in his bailiwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of June Anno Dom^m one thousand seven hundred and forty two to answer unto Francis Lee of a plea of trespass upon the case & And the same day is given to the aforesaid Francis here also

At which day here came the aforesaid Francis Lee by Robert Jenkins Henry his Attorney and the sheriff to wit John Sandy gent now here returned that he had taken the aforesaid John Waller whose body here at this day he had ready to answer the aforesaid Francis Lee of the aforesaid plea as to him it was commanded

Whereupon the aforesaid John Waller puts in his place Francis Allen gent Attorney at Law against the aforesaid Francis Lee of the aforesaid plea
