At which day here came again as well the ap- Robert Geddes as the ap- James Townsend by their Attorneys ap- And whereupon the said James as before defends the force and Injury when &c And says that he is not indebted to the ap- Robert Geddes the ap sum of thirty five pounds Curr. money and three hundred thirty eight pounds of Merchantable Tobacco or any part of the said money or tobacco in form of ... in which the same Robert Geddes above against him hath declared And of this he puts himself upon the Country &c

And hereupon the said Robert Geddes prays Leave thereof to Imparle here untill next Court to be held at dividing Creek in and for the County of ... the third Tuesday of August then next following and he hath it and the same day is given to the ap- James here also &c
