seven hundred and forty before his said Lordships Justice the peace in the County aforesaid to keep assigned by the oath of
twelve Jurors presented that Robert Geddes of Coventry parish for committing of waste on the Land belonging to John Worthey or
or about February last to the quantite of four thousand white Oak Shaves or thereabouts.

Thereupon it is Commaunded the sheriffe of Somerset County that he should take the said Robert Geddes if he should
be found in his bailiwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before this Justice of his Lordships County
Court of Somerset to be held at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of June one thousand seven hundred and forty one to answer
unto his said Lordship of the presentment aforesaid.

And now to wit the third Tuesday of June being the Twentieth day of the same month Anno Domini One thousand
Seven hundred and forty at a Court then held at dividing Creek in and for the County aforesaid before his Lordships Justice
James As well Robert Jenkins Henry Gent his said Lordships attorney who for his said Lordship in this part pro-
:cuted as the said Robert Geddes in his proper person and hereupon the said Robert Geddes is ordered to give
Recognizance in ten pounds Curr^t money of Maryland for his appearance at the next Court to be hold at dividing
Creek the third Tuesday of August then next following to answer &c and the same day is given to the said Rob^t Jenkins
Henry who &c. Thereupon the said Robert Geddes present known Court as aforesaid acknowledged himself indebted unto
his Lordship the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary of the province of Maryland in ten pounds Curr^t money of
said Province of his body goods or Chattels Lands or tenements to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors
to be made and paid If it happen that the said Robert Geddes doe not make his personall appearance before
the Justice of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be hold at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of August then next
